A Proud History

Our school has been in operation for over 150 years!

1864—Hepburn opened as a common school.

1870—The schoolhouse was built with local bricks around this time. It had one large room. This was later made into two rooms.

1870s—The school became a state school at some stage between 1873 and 1878.

1967—A third room was added to the school.

1970—The school was renamed Hepburn Primary School.

2023—Hepburn Primary School remains open.
